Product Description: This is the smallest backpack in the Airport series that can easily be taken on a plane and put under the seat or in the overhead. It will still hold a full array of gear, including a 300 2.8 with the lens hood reversed and the leather cover, as well as Pro size DSLR's. This model does not have tuck away shoulder straps.

Removable Laptop case – holds 15" laptops. Has a front organizer pocket and a shoulder strap.

Stretchable Front Pocket – locking zipper slider (like the Whip it Out) holds the laptop case securely in place.

Full featured shoulder straps – Same as the Airport Addicted.

Removable waistbelt – Similar to the Airport Addicted.

Top, Side, and Bottom Handle – Same as the Airport Addicted.

Top zippered pocket – Same as the Airport Addicted.

Business Card Holder – Same as the Airport Addicted.

Side Stretch pocket for monopods, etc. – Similar to the Airport Addicted.

Removable Rain Cover – seam sealed. Note it will cover the Bazooka tripod case.

Dividers – comes with plenty – see photos. Gear can be arranged with or without lenses attached.

Interior Space – can hold a 300 2.8 with hood reversed and leather cover, Pro size DSLR's, and plenty of other gear. See photos.



The main issue going through airports are **SIZE** and **WEIGHT**.

The 15" laptop case is located in a front stretch pocket for two reasons:

1. When it is removed, it reduces the size of the backpack.
2. When removed, it reduces the backpack weight 5-10 lbs.

Traditional photo backpacks do not decrease in size when the laptop is removed.



The front stretch pocket works similar to the Whip It Out.

The zipper slider is self-locking. So when the zipper is pulled up, the front stretch pocket compresses around the laptop case. It is very secure and will not fall out unless the bag is put upside down.

When getting to your seat on an airplane, it is very fast pulling out the laptop and then putting the backpack in the overhead compartment.



Many of the features and benefits are similar to the Airport Addicted backpack.

There are similar features like the side stretch pockets, handles on the top, side, and bottom, attachment method for monopods or tripods, etc.

One significant difference is that the back panel is curved for comfort.

Note that on this model, the shoulder straps do not tuck away.



This will hold up to a 300 mm 2.8 lens, with the hood reversed and the leather cover.

This backpack will satisfy 98% of all photo enthusiasts.

It will hold a full size DSLR, plus a 70-200 2.8, wide angles, strobes, and all other equipment.
