

Change Up™ Instructions

The Change Up™ can be worn as a shoulder bag, beltpack, or with the shoulder harness system included.

Beltpack



Used as a Beltpack

The Change-up™ can be used as a traditional belt pack.

Shoulder Bag



Tuck Away Waist Belt

Tuck the waist belt under the back pad on both sides.



Attaching The Shoulder Strap

Connect ONE shoulder strap to the D rings on the top of the bag.



Shoulder Strap for Support

ONE shoulder harness strap can be used as a shoulder strap to help SUPPORT the load and to ROTATE the belt pack from the back of your body to the front.



Modulus Components Attach

Modulus components such as the Lens Drop In can be attached to the rail on the either side of the waistbelt.

Beltpack with Shoulder Harness



Step 1: Use Shoulder Straps for Support

The Change Up™ can be supported by the two shoulder straps provided.



Step 2: Note the Straps Cross

Note that when worn, the shoulder straps cross behind your back.



Step 3: Locate Shoulder Straps

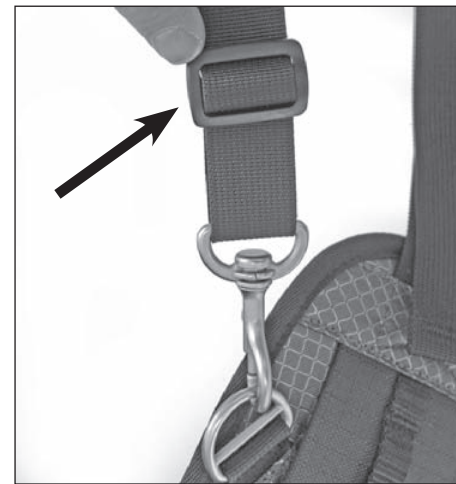
Locate the TWO shoulder harness straps.



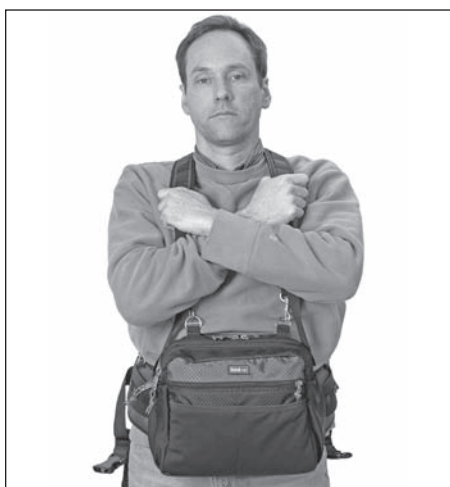
Step 4: Attach Shoulder Straps
Attach the shoulder straps as shown crossing the straps in the back.



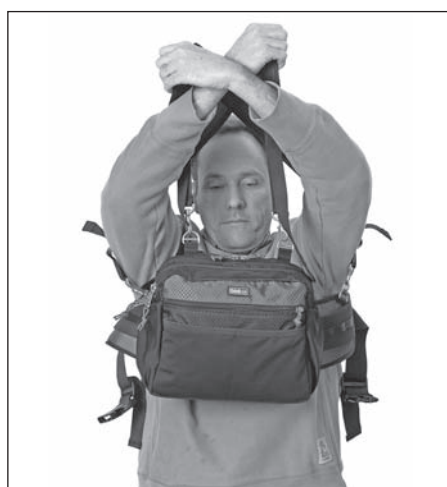
Step 5: Attachment to the Front
Make sure that the end of the shoulder strap with the buckle adjustment is connected to the front of the bag.



Step 6: Attachment to the Waist Belt
Clip the side with the "triglide" adjustment buckle to the waistbelt. This buckle can also be used to adjust the length of the shoulder strap.



Step 7: Taking it Off and On
Unclip the buckle on the waistbelt. Cross your arms and grab either side of the shoulder straps.



Step 8: Pulling it over your head
Using a quick motion, pull the straps up over your head and remove the bag. Use the same method to put it back on.



Step 9: Practice
PRACTICE taking the bag on and off. The motion will become very easy and natural after you have used it several times.



Step 10: Adjusting the Shoulder Straps
Pull on the webbing straps to adjust the shoulder harness.



Step 11: Sitting Down
When sitting down, the bag can be positioned upwards very quickly by pulling on the webbing straps.

Internal Dimensions:
10.5" L x 4" W x 9" D;
27 x 10 x 23 cm
(the bag is soft and flexible, and will flex to lenses and various items)

External Dimensions:
11" L x 4.375" W x 9.5" D;
28 x 11 x 24 cm

Weight:

(715 - 1090 grams)
Weight varies based on the accessories used.
